

## **Dear Community Water Customer:**

Mountain Regional Water is excited to provide an update on the annexation of the Community Water service area into our district. The Annexation of the properties contained in the Community Water service area has been completed. The Annexation and Asset Acquisition Agreement between Mountain Regional Water and TCFC, the current owner of the Community Water Company, is scheduled to close on August 30<sup>th</sup>. Once closed, Mountain Regional Water will own and operate the system previously known as Community Water.

Current Community Water customers can expect to begin receiving bills from Mountain Regional Water in early October. These bills will be based on September's usage and will follow our adopted rate structure. Mountain Regional Water is also happy to report that construction on the water system improvements to the Community Water system are moving forward. As you may know, Mountain Regional obtained a subsidized loan from the State Division of Drinking Water for \$2,600,000 at a 2.0% annual interest rate to pay for these improvements. This equates to a \$26.50 monthly assessment. Billing for the monthly infrastructure assessment, used to repay the Drinking Water loan, similarly begins following the August 30<sup>th</sup> closing discussed above. Once adopted, the assessment fee will be included in the first bill received from Mountain Regional Water in early October.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u> – The Administrative Control Board of the Mountain Regional Water Special Service District, Summit County, Utah, will meet in regular public session to receive a staff explanation, entertain public comment, deliberate, and make a final decision on the establishment of a new water rate and infrastructure assessment for the former customers of the Community Water Company, whose customers were annexed into the District. ## MOUNTAIN REGIONAL WATER SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO.

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE DISTRICT-WIDE RATES & FEES SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated (UCA) §17B-1-643, the administrative control board of a special service district, after holding a properly noticed public hearing, may adopt a resolution establishing rates and fees for services provided by that district; and,

WHEREAS, the Administrative Control Board of the Mountain Regional Water Special Service District (the "District") held a properly noticed public hearing on August 16, 2018 with regard to an amendment to the District-Wide Rates & Fees Schedule as it pertains to the annexation of the Community Water Company system customers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Annexation and Asset Acquisition Agreement, dated May 30, 2018, the District committed to various upgrades and replacements of the Community Water Company system, necessitating the issuance of a long term, low interest bond to be purchased by the Utah Division of Drinking Water (the "Bond"); and,

**WHEREAS,** this amendment to the District-Wide Rates & Fees Schedule is necessary to pay for the annualized costs of indebtedness associated with the repayment of the Bond;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to UCA §17B-1-643, the Administrative Control Board of the Mountain Regional Water Special Service District, Summit County, State of Utah, hereby amends the District-Wide Rates & Fees Schedule as follows:

**Section 1:** Amendment and Adoption. The Administrative Control Board hereby amends and establishes a District-Wide Rates & Fees Schedule attached hereto as **Exhibit A.** 

**Section 2:** Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect on September 1, 2018.

# Mountain Regional Water Special Service District District-Wide Rates & Fees Schedule

### Water Rates

### Amount

#### Residential

Mountain Regional's standard Residential water rates are based upon one (1) Equivalent Residential Connection (ERC). Most residences are billed at this rate. However, at the time the building permit is issued for a residential customer, the customer may choose to be billed at one (1) ERC, or select to be billed using the ERCs based upon quantity of water purchased with that lot's impact fee.

For example, if a lot is assessed an impact fee based upon 1.5 ERCs, the customer may choose to be billed at either one (1) ERC, or one and a half (1.5) ERCs. Once a customer selects an ERC amount, it can't be changed. The minimum ERCs for billing purposes is one (1.0), for which the monthly billing rates are shown below.

When a customer selects to use the ERCs based upon the quantity of water, both the base rate and the quantity of gallons in each rate block are multiplied by that ERC amount; while the usage block rates per 1,000 gallons remain the same. The impact of this on the rate schedule for one and a half (1.5) ERCs is shown below. In this case, the customer will pay a higher base rate, but will also be able to use a larger quantity of water before reaching the higher conservation usage rates.
